

Village Morning Art Classes

Spanish Village Art Center Summer Camp 2008

Each day the class is divided into 2 parts (1½ hours each)

- a. Creative Clay by Elizabeth Woolrych, Studio 6, learn basic hand building, try the potter's wheel and create masks, animal mugs & rattles.
- b. Exposure to Art by Charlotte Ibach, Studio 10, collect natural objects on a hike through Balboa Park. Then carve, cut, drill, paint, and bead your found objects to be transformed into walking sticks, animal masks, crowns, or stick dolls.

Classes are for children age 6 and up.

Classes will begin at 9 am and end at 12 noon.

We suggest play clothes, sunscreen and a snack.

Our one-week classes take place July 14 – August 29

\$130 per child for one week. (includes both classes)

We supply all materials, supplies and kiln firings.

We now offer supervised walking to the other afternoon programs in the Park- \$5 each.
