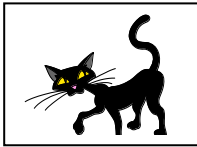


CATNIP CONNECTION 12

JUROR: Renee Corwin is an award winning portrait painter. A native New Yorker, Renee attended the School of Visual Arts in New York City where she earned a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree. Her professional career started as a textile artist where she was a colorist and designer for two decades as well as a graphic designer. Her move to San Diego brought her back to her first joy, painting. Renee is the past President of the San Diego Portrait Society and a past member of the California Art Club & The Portrait Society of America. Renee teaches portraiture and painting in Escondido.

AWARDS: Cash Awards for First, Second and Third Place, three Honorable Mention Certificates and a special People's Choice Award (awarded at the end of the show.)

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all artists residing in San Diego County.

SALES: All work must be for sale and must remain hanging on gallery walls until the close of the show on July 2. Artist will receive 70% of sale, with a 20% commission to Gallery 21 and a 10% donation to the San Diego Feral Cat Coalition.

SPECIFICATIONS:

~ All 2D and 3D original artwork can be entered for jurying. Not previously exhibited in Gallery 21. Suitable for family viewing.

~ Work must be original by the artist and not derived from copyrighted or published material. No art created under instruction. No giclée prints.

2-DIMENSIONAL WORK

MUST be framed or have all sides of piece finished and supported by proper gauge wire suitable for hanging. No sawtooth hangers. Work cannot exceed 40" in any direction. Pieces larger than 24" x 30" must be faced with Plexiglas.
NO PHOTOGRAPHY OR DIGITAL ART.

3-DIMENSIONAL WORK

Freestanding works may not exceed 36" in height. Work requiring a pedestal must be no more than 15" wide at the base and must not weigh over 30 pounds. No work requiring electricity.

Gallery 21 is in a high-traffic tourist area and is open every day 11:00am to 4:00pm.

SITTING THE GALLERY:

There is no paid staff, so each accepted artist must either sit the gallery for a 2-1/2 hour shift during the show, or pay a \$25 sitting fee.

All sitters will review the sitters & sales instructions provided in a notebook when they arrive for their designated sitting day/time. If you are on the sitting calendar and cancel your sitting assignment; you will be expected to find someone to take your place OR pay the \$25 sitter fee.

The juror and the organizers of the Catnip Connection Show reserve the right to disallow a work that does not meet the specified criteria as listed in this prospectus.

Although the utmost care will be taken in handling the artwork, Gallery 21 and the organizers of the Catnip Connection Show cannot be responsible for damage or loss, whatever the cause. Artists should carry their own insurance.

SUBMISSION FOR ENTRY:

ENTRY FEES:

\$20 for the first entry; \$10 for each additional entry.
No limit on number of entries.

EMAIL: All artwork entries must be submitted as digital images emailed as an attachment.

Digital image should be in .jpg format with the longest side set to 1200 pixels.

The managers of Catnip Connection will place this art in the gallery after delivery. No additional art may be brought in during the run of the show.
